
Measuring Tips to Remember

- Always use a steel tape measure for accuracy.
- Round each measurement to the nearest 1/8".
- To eliminate errors, always measure the width first and write it down, then measure the height next and write it down.
- Measure the width in three places (top, middle, bottom) and use the narrowest measurement. Measure the height in three places (left, middle, right) and use the longest
- If ordering an inside mount, measure window depth.
- Always measure at least twice before recording your final measurement.
- Two windows may appear to be the same size, but rarely have the identical measurements. Take separate measurements for each window.
- Do not take any deductions from your measurements. The manufacturer will make any necessary deductions.
